
Today we are going to go on a shape hunt. Can you make a shape scanner? What is this? If you look at the picture below it shows you an example. Can you take this on your daily walk and look for different shapes? Or you can do it around the home can you find a triangle, circle, rectangle and square? Once the play-dough is made wrap it in Clingfilm/plastic wrap and then store in an airtight container you can then continue using for the next few activity suggestions as well as free play and making letters or setting challenges can you make our house out of play-dough, a dinosaur, monster or person etc.

Use the play-dough to help with shape formation: ask them to make a shape such as a 'circle' out of the play-dough. If you don't have the ingredients or time to make play-dough ask your child to write the numbers you call out or you can make it more fun by getting them to use their finger to make the numbers in a tray of flour, sand, sugar, rice etc. or you can use sticks in the garden or on a walk. If they make a mistake show them the correct way and get them to copy then rub them out and ask them to do it themselves and see if they then do it correctly.




Once you have found at least I item for each shape how many side do they have? (answers in the picture on the left) How many vertices/corners do they have?

#### Tuesday: Thinking about spring.

The other week your challenge was to think about spring and go on a spring walk, bug hunting, looking at flowers and talking about the weather. Your challenge today is to tell me what you see, hear, feel, smell and taste in the spring. Go stand outside or go on your daily walk and think about your senses.

I see...green grass. I see beautiful flowers growing (what colour are they?). I see lots of animals like birds carrying food and twigs for the nests. I also see lots of baby animals like chicks. I see the bright sun in the blue sky.

I hear... birds chirping in the garden and people talking and laughing. A lawn mower going.

I feel/touch...the hot sun on my skin it is making me warm and hot. The breeze blowing my hair. The soft grass under my feet.

I smell...the flowers they are lovely and smell like perfume. I smell a BBQ someone must be having their lunch or dinner. I smell cut grass.

I taste...the BBQ being cooking in next door's garden. I taste chocolate because in spring time we have Easter and Easter eggs. I taste ice cream to cool me down in the hot sun.

Your challenge today is to tell me who is in your family can you write it down using a pencil and paper or in the sand/sugar/rice/flour etc.

- Remember what do you need at the beginning of a sentence? A Capital letter!
- What do you need at the end of a sentence? A full stop.
- Don't forget your finger spaces between words.

Are they big and round, large, small, bright or narrow? Are they tall or short? How do they feel? What does their mouth look like and their nose? Are they big, small or long? What are they wearing?

You can download for free different compass apps on your phone or tablet and allow your child to use this to find where North, East, South and West are. Now time to test how fast you are at running and if you can remember where North, East, South and West are. 

The 5 oceans are:

- Pacific Ocean the light blue ocean in the picture below. It is the largest and deepest ocean.
- Atlantic Ocean is the pink one it is the second largest ocean
- Indian Ocean is the yellow one and it is the third largest ocean in the world.
- Arctic Ocean is the dark blue/dark grey ocean at the top of the map in the North. It is the smallest Ocean.
- Southern or Antarctic Ocean is the green ocean at the bottom of the map in the South.

The oceans cover 71% of Earth. So there is more water on Earth than there is land!

Also what is the imaginary line that goes around the middle of the earth that is also separating the pacific and Atlantic ocean into north and south? It is the equator! If you are closer to it then it is hot if you are far away it is cold! What oceans are coldest? Yes the Arctic and Antarctic Oceans!



**Thursday:** What ocean animal can you make out of things around your house you can also use recycling to do this. You could make them out of playdough, salt-dough, or draw them?

- Think of other animals and have a look online to find out which oceans they live in.



# Recycled Egg Carton




**Friday:** Can you build or draw an ocean scene or collage pictures to make an ocean scene/seascape.
