

Monday: This week your topic is based on space. Today you are going to create a space book that you can put all of your English work in this week and even put your topic work in or pictures of it in. these can be as creative as you want or as simple as you want.

The examples I have attached have a front cover saying 'My space book' and remember to put your name on it to!

Then you can have a page for each of these make sure you draw it or print a picture or cut a picture from a magazine and label it to.

- Earth
- Sun
- Moon
- Stars
- Planets (Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune)
- Rocket ship or spaceship or both






Tuesday: This week your topic is based on space. Today you are going to label some pictures for me first a rocket and then if you want to an astronaut. Watch this video to help you learn about astronauts https://youtu.be/iP4SKI9I4w4

Label a rocket by ether writing the correct words on the correct line or cutting and sticking words that a parent or guardian has written out. If you can't print this out, then draw your own rocket and label.

- Bottom line on the right- exhaust flames

Wednesday: what does an alien look like? Can you draw me an alien how do you think they would look? Next can you label and describe your alien to me?




- Are they scary, cute, pretty, strange etc?
- What colour are they? Are they the same colour all over?
- Are they smart, clever or silly?
- What does their face look like? How many eyes are they big or small? Do they have a nose? Ears? Mouth? Teeth?
- Do they have an antenna?
- Are they wearing clothes? What do they look like? What colour?
- What is their name?
- Do they have a family? Mum? Dad? Brother? Sister?
- Do they have any pets if so, what do they look like?
- What do they like doing? Dancing, football, music, painting?
- Where do they live? House, underground, in a spaceship?
- Do they have any special powers?


Get your child to draw/design an alien they can do this using recycled materials to make one or draw one or trace one into sand. Then get them to label it like the one on the left.

Thursday: what 10 things would you take to space with you? Draw an outline of a spaceship with 10 bullet points like the picture below and get your child to think about what they would take to space with them. 
- What do you need to survive? Food, water etc. What food would you take is it your favourite food?
- What do you use everyday that you could not go without?
- What are you going to use an entertainment? Book, magazine, tv, tablet etc?
- Are you going to take anyone with you? Family, friends, pet etc?
- What do astronauts need to take with them? Helmet, spacesuit etc?

Friday: Imagine you are going to the moon or another plant what would you do? Think about all the things you have talked or written about so far this week you can include these in your short piece or writing. Watch this video about the book 'if I was an astronaut' hopefully it will give you ideas about what you would do in space. https://youtu.be/9wV8yw7iV8w



- What would you see? Aliens? Animals? Plants? Sand?
- what would you hear? Quiet? loud? Sirens?
- Smell? Nice? Horrible?
- Touch? What can you feel? Is it hot or cold? Can you feel the ground is it rough like because there is sand or is it wet because there is water?
- What does it taste like? Does the air taste sweet or salty?
- How would you feel? Happy, scared, excited?
- How did you get to the moon? Car, boat, train, plane, spaceship, space rocket?
- What would you do how would you sleep?
- What would you eat?
- What would you do?

Talk through these and get your child to explain what they see on their planet or the moon you could get them to draw a picture to show you and then add short sentences to describe what they see (e.g It is a Alien. I can see a monster.) If they find this easy then get

them to write a small paragraph of sentences about what they see. Of you can do something like the picture on the left.

Topic: Space

- Is the sky moving? How can you tell?


Can you draw a picture of both day and night pictures of what you can see or draw pictures? You can even take photos maybe your parent or guardian can take a picture of the night sky for you as you will probably be in bed by the time it starts to get dark. What do you need to induce in the day picture that you don't need to in the night photo? What is in the night photo but not the day photo? Can you label your photo for me? Think about what you see and do during the day and what you see and do at night.



You can even look up on the internet pictures of the sky at night. If you do not have a computer/iPad/phone to connect to the Internet:

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
Wednesday: Today we are going to look at the stars and their constellations.

A constellation is a group of stars that make a pattern in the sky. The pattern may look like an animal, creature, person or an object.

Your job is to try to make a constellation. (links below are for pictures of real constellations) You could:

- Draw it

- Use uncooked spaghetti and marshmallows or other sweets.



Here are some examples to ignite your imagination and creativity!



Friday: another craft day today you have a few options of things to make check what you have at home and see what you can make here are some ideas:

- Make a paper mache planet (tear some newspaper into strips submerge in glue (flour and water) and stick around a rolled-up ball of newspaper or foil and allow to fry then paint it to look like earth or one of the other planets.
- Space pies- use mud and water to make a pie for an alien what would an alien like in their pie?
 Grass, leaves, sticks, shells, sand etc?
- Make the solar system using plastic lids and pens or paint (picture below)
- Solar system hat (see picture below)
- Make a jet pack out of recycling (picture below)
- Make a picture of our planet Earth (example below)
- Turn a picture of you into an astronaut (example below)

- draw one
- make one by using your recycling
- You could use as little as a: toilet roll tube, paper and a black pen!
- Make one out of playdough or salt dough use shells and rocks for the eyes and mouth, twigs for legs and arms maybe even grass as the hair!
- Make an alien mask to wear

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
