2:00-3:00	Geography	Ordinance survey maps This lesson focuses on Ordnance Survey maps and basic map reading skills. You will examine map of the local area and discuss what you can see on it, you will be taught to read four-figure grid references. You will also be introduced to the geographical concept of scale, and map symbols. Ordnance Survey is Britain's mapping agency. OS create up to date and accurate maps depicting the landscape's human and physical features. All OS maps use the same symbols, which are included in a key so people using the map know what each symbol represents. The symbols represent human features e.g. information points and physical features e.g. forest. Go through each slide and read the key information and complete each activity.
