10:45-11.30	Maths	<ul> <li>Today is the final lesson focusing on shapes. First, using the document available on the school website, recap the names of common 2D and 3D shapes. How many sides and vertices does each 2D shape have? How many faces, edges and vertices do the 3D shapes have? Once you have done this there are a variety of activities for you to complete.</li> <li>Activity I – using shape cut outs/stamps/draw the shapes, create a 2D shape pattern. Can you make a repeating pattern? Can you make a symmetrical pattern? A symmetrical pattern is a pattern where the matching shapes are in the same order from the middle. The pattern can be looked at from right or left and will be the same.</li> <li>Activity 2 – using materials such as spaghetti string, blue tac, marshmallows etc, can you create the following 3D shapes: cuboid, cube, square based pyramid, cylinder.</li> <li>Activity 3 – working with an adult or someone else at home, you need to draw the 2D shape that they are describing. For example, they might say draw 2 short lines on the left and right. Now draw 2 longer lines at the top and bottom and join all 4 lines together at the vertices. You have made a rectangle.</li> </ul>
