



Internet safety workshop Delivered by the 2 Johns



The workshop will look at the online world and how young people are using it; how they are navigating around restrictions and using the internet without their parent's knowledge.

This will include their favourite apps and games.

We will look at the dangers they face not only from predatory bad people but also how they are being groomed in games, from receiving gifts for the younger player to being groomed on servers for the older children.

We will look at how all our young people are being influenced online and forming ideologies and views that might be diametric to their parents, which can give them a skewed view of the world. We look at how influencers work, which can lead our children to conduct dangerous challenges.

Parents are shown solutions they can adopt to help keep their children safe, from settings on apps to safe use of games and how parents should approach the online arena.

We take the Stranger Danger message that parents are familiar with, updated for 2021.
