

HOW WILL MY CHILD BE SUPPORTED WITH TRANSITIONS?

Transitions from pre-schools/nursery schools:

- Pupils due to join our reception class visit the school/classroom prior to starting and meet with staff. Where a child already has identified special educational needs, the SENCo will also visit the child in their pre-school setting and home visits with the Reception teacher..

Transitions from class to class:

- Prior to the start of a new academic year, class teachers and LSAs receive information about the SEND children in their class, including their One Plan and Reviews. Relevant training/courses are arranged for teachers/LSAs as needed.

Transitions to/from another primary school:

- All children with SEND can visit the school and have a tour prior to starting to familiarise themselves with the staff, school structure, and main sites including toilets, hall, playground etc.
- We have a highly skilled pastoral team to monitor well-being. All school SEND records are passed on to any other school a child transfers to.

Transitions to secondary school:

- Where children with SEND are transferring to Secondary School, the SENDCo will contact the secondary school to transfer SEND information and discuss transition support.
- All pupils in Y6 are offered transition visits to their secondary school.
